- Red Hook High School Class of 2024 prospective graduate
- Acceptance/attendance at a local college, either a 2 or 4 year school will be given <u>preference</u>,
 although all are encouraged to apply
- A willingness to contribute by way of advocacy and/or service to the AFF. This will be a
 commitment of 5 -10 hours during the year starting in September 2024 and ending in April
 2025. Your role with us may include:
 - volunteering for a local non-profit organization whose work aligns with one of our mission goals
 - o assisting with Red Hook Responds
 - o attending remotely two AFF meetings, one in the fall and one in the spring
 - o organizing a service project meeting one of our mission goals

The Ascienzo Family Foundation <u>ascienzofamilyfoundation.org</u> is a local nonprofit organization, whose mission focuses on addressing food insecurity, providing educational opportunities to the underserved, and aiding the elderly. The AFF was founded in 2014

by former RH teacher, Nick Ascienzo, and its Board members currently include Ali Fraenkel (RHHS '11), Brittany Mosher (RHHS '05), Sophie Laing (RHHS '12), former Red Hook teacher Frances Thompson (RHHS '76), former teacher Sue Kaiser, and current teacher Jen Melitski at LAMS. Our ambassadors have the opportunity to apply for grants on behalf of organizations for which they advocate. We also have an open application available for local community members through which they may apply for funds.
